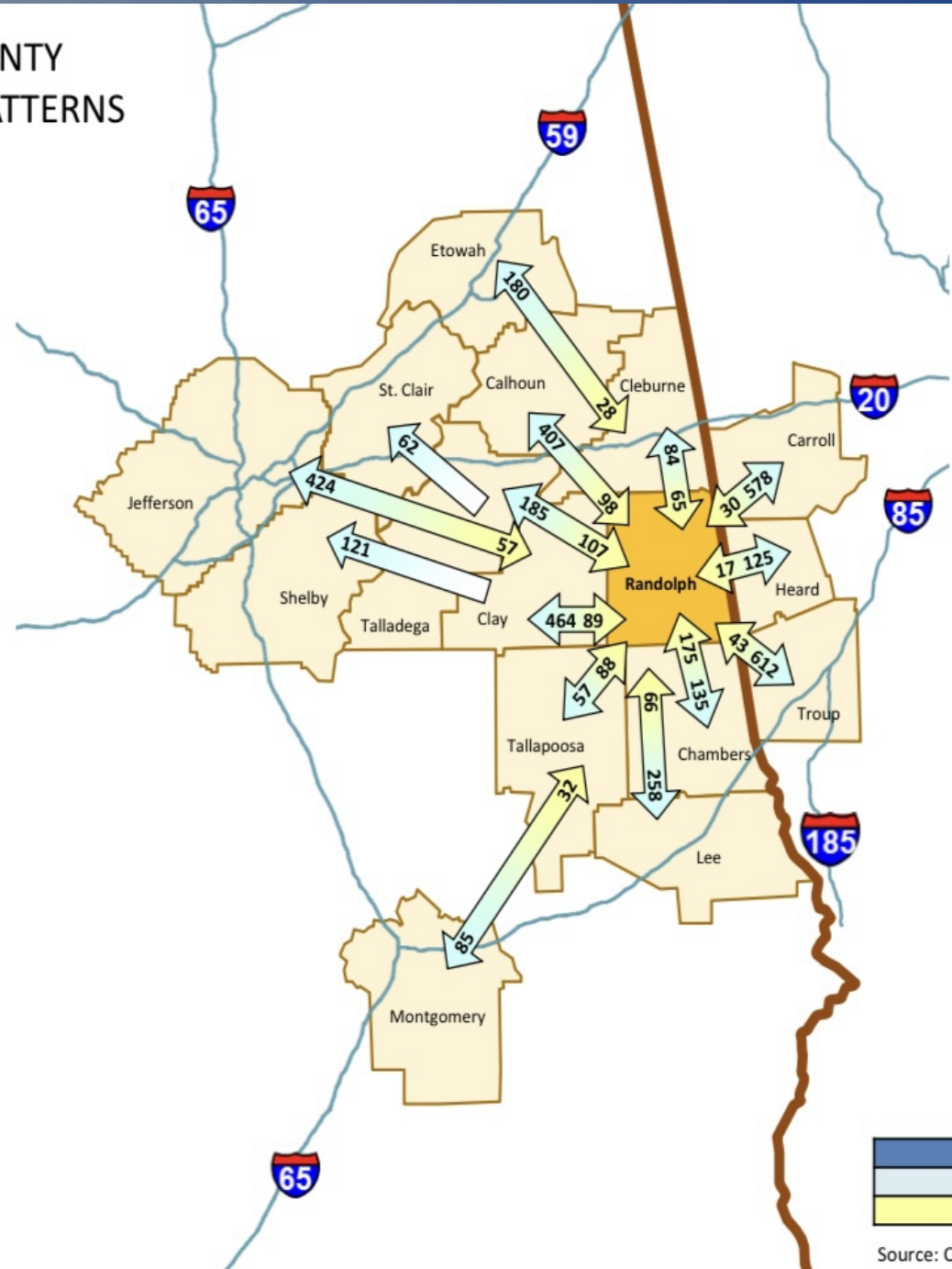
Economic Statistics

- ▶ Per median income- \$43,000
- ▶ 22% Poverty, 30% in the NW Census Tract, Lake Area only 10%.
- ▶ The current poverty rate for the region is 18.%, 4.3% higher than the national average, and 0.9% higher than the state average.
- ▶ The median household income is \$43,000, while the state median is \$46,472 and the national median is \$57,652.
- ▶ AL is the 6th poorest state
- ▶ Could double land tax and still be 50th

Workforce

- ▶ 50% labor force participation rate
- ▶ 8,406 workers living in the county
- ▶ 1,790 coming in
- ▶ 2,856 stays within
- ▶ 5,550 leave the county
- ▶ Living & Employed in the selection area-34%
- ▶ Living in the selection area but employed outside-66%
- ▶ Average drive time is 27 minutes
